(*) *The Sevier County Sponsored Lunch Ride is provided to the first 25 riders from a select menu. The ride is 75 miles round trip. You can sign up at the East Millard Fair Grounds when you sign in and receive your welcome packet. Checking the block for the lunch run does not guarantee your lunch, but it does put you on the list for the first 25 just in case it's offered, which is looking pretty darn good right now. Wednesday's lunch is Mexican, Thursday's lunch is Chinese and Friday's lunch is Italian. This menu could change.*

Special Note ** Wild Mustang Ride; (Trailer Ride) Take a ride through the Swasey Wild Horse Herd Management Area for an opportunity to view wild horses in their natural habitat. The Swasey HMA, which has a population of 180 wild horses, is located 35 miles west of Delta and is a little over an hour drive from Fillmore. This ride of approximately 25 miles on two track and county maintained roads is suitable for all skill types. Several common watering sources will be visited where horses frequent. A pair of field glasses and a camera are recommended for viewing. Wednesday ride only.

Amasa Basin Ride: (Trailer Ride) Amasa Basin offers a unique opportunity to view the desert from about 9,500 feet. Drive through the high desert aspen and pine forests. Take a look back in time to an old mining community and various unique rock formations. Take in a view of Notch Peak with its 3,000 foot vertical cliffs. Don't forget your camera. You will be amazed at what the desert looks like at 9,000 feet. Thursday ride only.
